

# **Keyworth Parish Council Neighbourhood Plan Advisory Committee**

## **Minutes of meeting**

The meeting was held in the Centenary lounge of Keyworth Parish Hall starting at 10.25am on Wednesday 17th January 2018 with Nic Seller chairing and Kevin Fitzgerald, Tony Wells and Chris Kemp in attendance.

The meeting was called to consider correspondence arising out of the questions asked by the external examiner concerning our draft neighbourhood plan.

In addition a letter had been received from East Leake Parish Council advising any Parish Council or community group considering preparing a Neighbourhood Plan not to bother. It was noted that this seemed to be an increasingly common sentiment.

The correspondence from Richard Mapletoft, RBC Planning Policy Manager, proposing changes to our draft Neighbourhood Plan, had been circulated prior to the meeting. Nic Seller had prepared a draft response based on emails circulated, of concern was the proposed marginalising of our policy on housing density and mix for the new developments on the edge of the village. With minor editorial modification to the draft text it was agreed that it be sent to Richard Mapletoft by our Parish Council Clerk and copied to our Borough Councillor's. It would also be made available to all Keyworth Parish Councillors with a request that our strategy be endorsed by the full council meeting on the 22<sup>nd</sup> January.
